# What is a Design Sprint

A design sprint is a collaborative and focussed 15 Day module designed to bring all stakeholders across the table to define, ideate & create a better product.



# Who is it suited for?

From a startup to a multinational, a Design sprint can work for any team of individuals who want an hands-on approach in the progression of an idea to a design.



For those who are **just getting started** with an idea or looking to go-to-market quickly, the design sprint helps hasten the process in an all-inclusive approach.

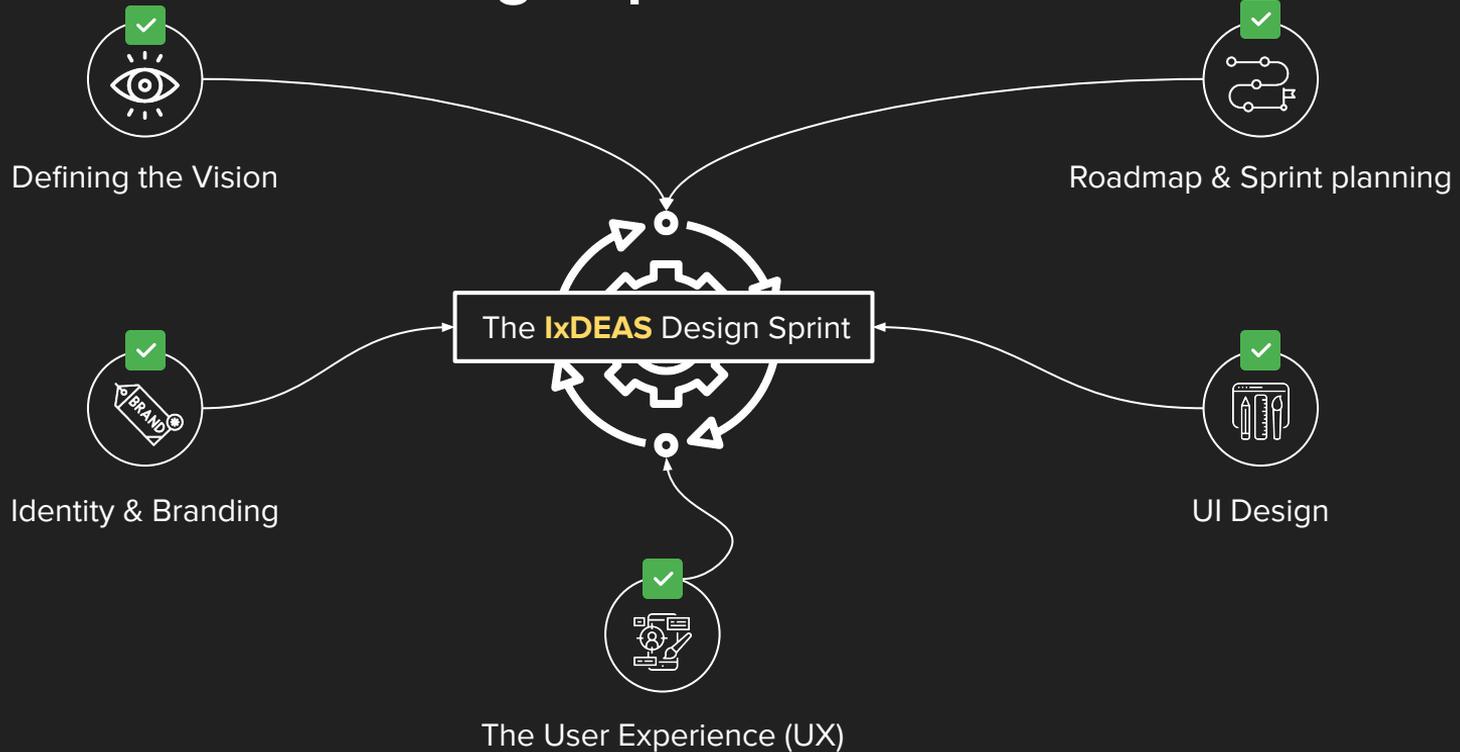


Looking for **new features** or to **revamp your product**? This process could bring your collective combined knowledge together to create an informed and data driven design.



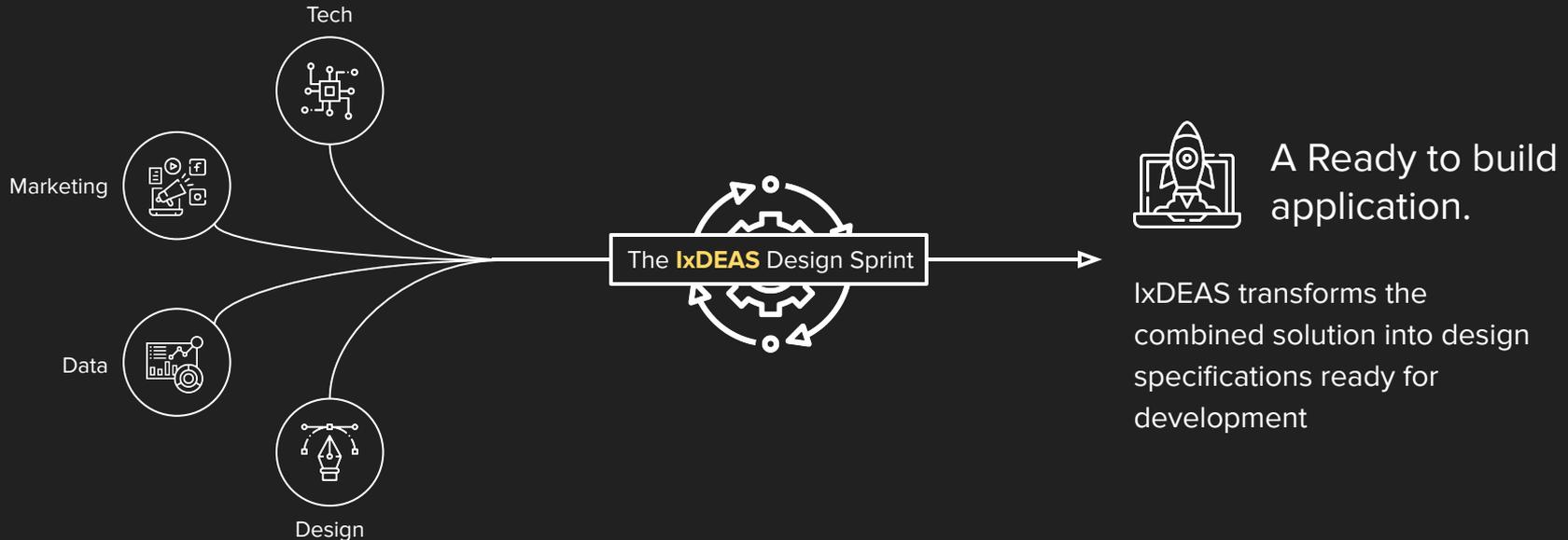
Does your **team have an idea** that needs to be turned into reality? Validate your idea using all your team members' knowledge and present prototypes and designs that are ready to be deployed.

# What all does a Design Sprint Include?



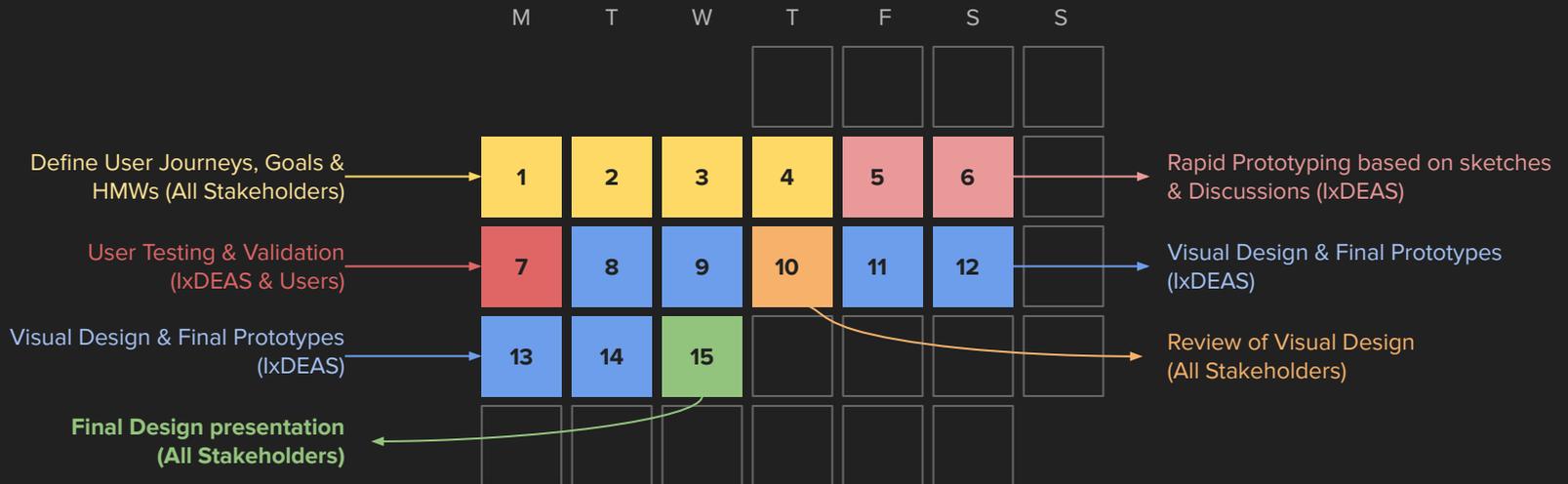
# How do you gain?

Aimed to finish on the 15th day, this design sprint requires a minimum of 4 days with all stakeholders.



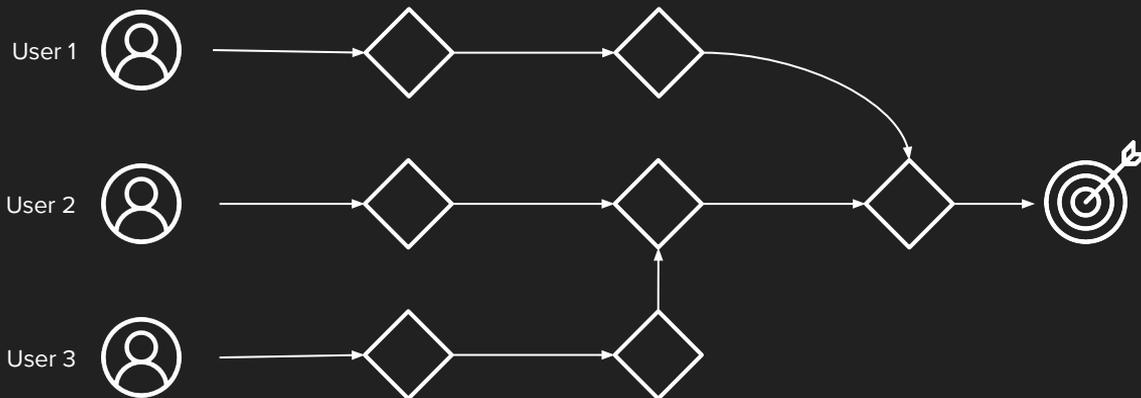

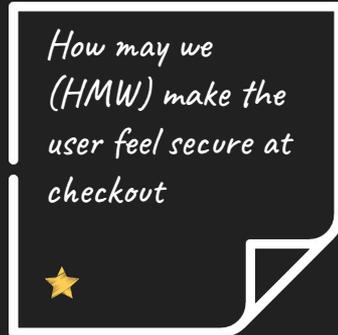
# Day 1: User Journeys & Goal Setting

Using the Vision put forth by the stakeholders, we start defining the different user types their goal (common or multiple) and the shortest route/ journey.



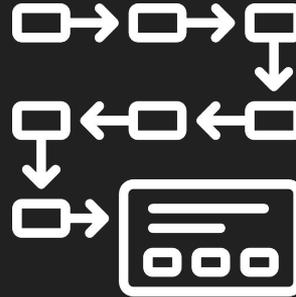
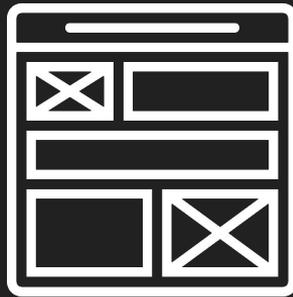
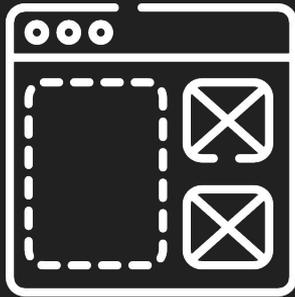
## Day 2: The How May/Might We (HMW) Questions

Listing down the 'How May/Might We' (HMW) is a known activity to help rephrase known challenges into questions. HMWs are non-solution oriented and portray a specific challenge with a positive outcome. The team then collectively votes to agree and arrive at the set of challenges that need to be tackled.



# Day 3 & 4: Brainstorm & Ideate

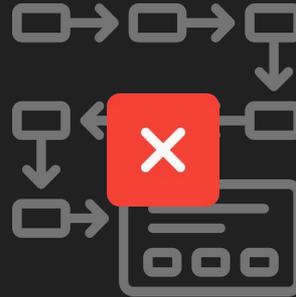
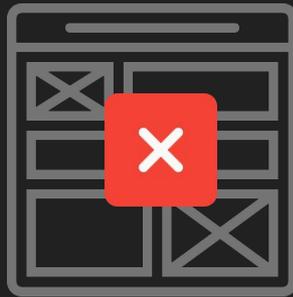
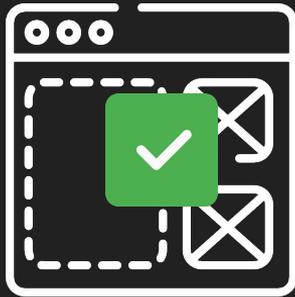
**Today is all about solutions.** Using HMWs from Day 2 as a starting point, templates and tools provided help put pen to paper and form solutions in the form of sketches. With minimal detailing this fast-paced exercises focuses on creating multiple solutions.



# Day 3 & 4: (Contd)

## Brainstorm & Ideate

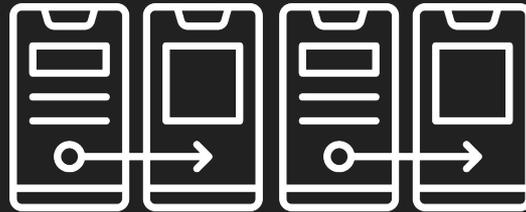
As a group we collectively present, discuss, iterate and agree on solutions that help users achieve the target/goal. As stakeholders we agree on functionality, practicality, needs and the ability to execute.

# Prototyping

The IxDEAS team collates the solutions selected, and creates high-fidelity interactive prototypes that are real enough to validate. This includes mapping out the flow for each solution restricting the prototype to only show the steps we want to test.



# Day 7

## Testing & Validation

Selecting a set of on-site and remote users we test the interactive prototypes. During these sessions we look for patterns, ability to navigate, and interactions at decision points. Successfully validated ideas move ahead, while feedback on others are addressed and decided upon.



# Day 8 - 15

## Visual Design

IxDEAS and its designers work on existing Brand Guidelines or develop a unique visual style to apply on the validated low-fidelity prototypes. Typography, Colors, Iconography and Imagery are some of the elements used to create the final designs in very realistic interactive prototypes. A library of assets is provided for easy integration into code.

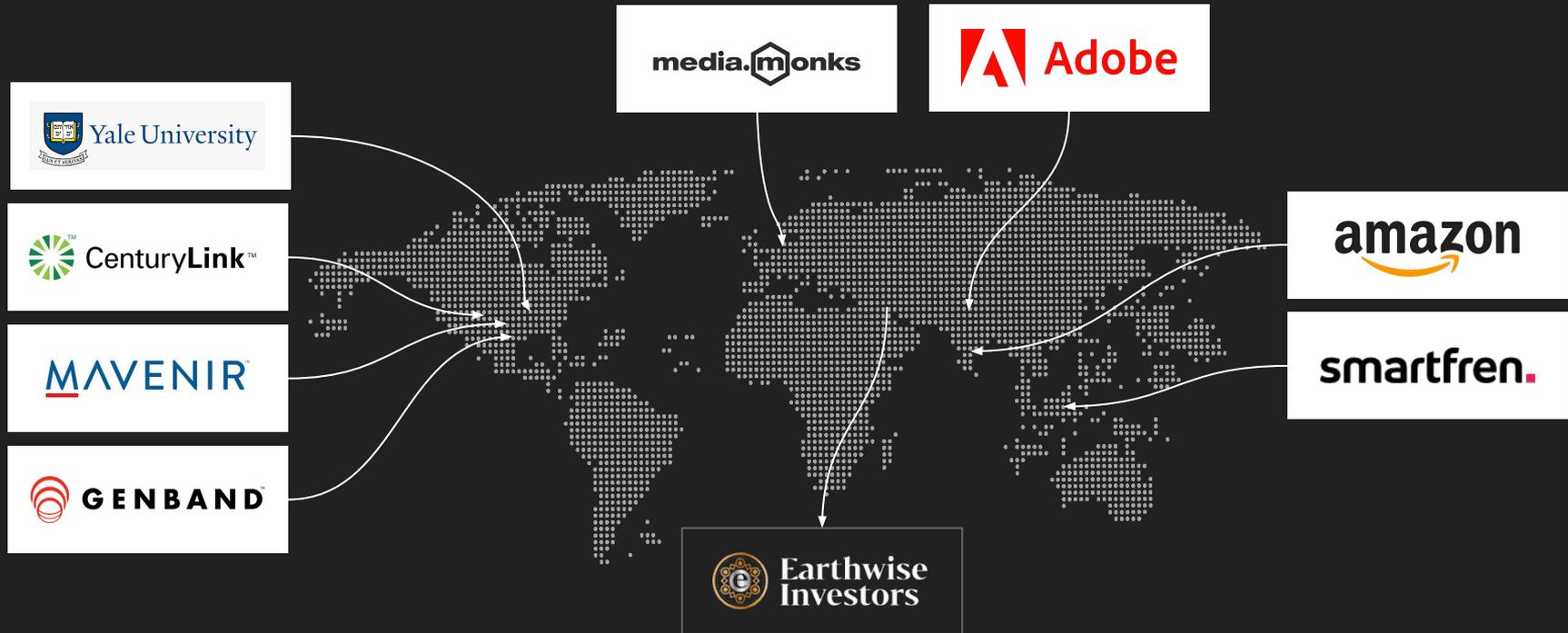
